



Privacy Policy for Jampics.com

I. JAMPICS.COM (the "Company") is in the business of providing high-quality concert photography images of improvisational and popular musicians for both commercial and non-commercial uses and of creating an environment to support the growth and prosperity of said musicians by exposing their likeness and offer insight to their live performances to consumers. As such, the Company respects your individual privacy. This Privacy Statement protects your privacy by:

A. Informing you about:

- i.** the type of personal information the Company collects about you through this Web site
- ii.** how that information is collected
- iii.** the general purposes for which that information is collected
- iv.** what disclosures of information will be made
- v.** how, and to what extent, you can limit those disclosures

B. Assuring you that:

III. Collecting Personal Information
